VISEGRAD GRANTS -VISEGRAD GRANT, VISEGRAD GRANT+, STRATEGIC GRANT

Visegrad Fund annually allocates approximately EUR 10 million to hundreds of Visegrad cooperation projects and mobility programs across Central and Eastern Europe.

The project should be implemented in a consortium

Visegrad grant- The international consortium should be composed rom at least 3 V4 countries OR Bilateral cross-border cooperation of at least 2 organizations from 2 neighboring V4 countries also qualify for support with projects taking place within a 40-km radius from the border and focusing on a local issue

Visegrad grant+- active involvement of at least 3 V4 countries and 1 entity from the Eastern Partnership region (EaP) or the Western Balkans countries (WB) at minimum (3xV4 + 1xEaP/WB format). However, if the applicant is from one of the EaP or WB countries, it is enough to involve two V4 countries in the project consortium, if another EaP/WB country is also involved (2xV4 + 2xEaP/WB format).

Strategic grant- Projects must be developed by organizations from all V4 countries

COST- EUROPEAN COOPERATION IN SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

COST funds interdisciplinary research networks.

The funding a COST Action receives covers the expenses of networking activities rather than research. As such is used to organise and fund events, Short-term Scientific Missions, Training Schools, communication activities, and virtual networking tools. An estimated €125,000 is made available for a COST Action in its first year and an average of €150,000 per year for the other 3 years.

Deadline: 23. October 2024.

Participation in COST Actions has led to significant results and follow-up in terms of the number of proposals submitted for collaborative research in Framework Programmes, with a success rate which more than triple the average success rates for these programmes (37% success rate). By funding networking, COST acts as a pre-portal for further research and innovation funding such as Horizon Europe, the European Union's Framework Programme for Research and Innovation.

The LIFE Calls for proposals 2024 have been published on the <u>Funding & tender opportunities</u> <u>portal</u> on 18 April 2024.

Subprograms:

The **Nature and Biodiversity** sub-programme will aim at the protection and restoration of Europe's nature and halting and reversing biodiversity loss. Thus, the LIFE Nature and Biodiversity sub-programme will continue to fund nature conservation projects, in particular in the areas of biodiversity, habitats and species. It will support projects that contribute to the implementation of the EU <u>Birds</u> and <u>Habitats</u> directives, and in particular the development and management of the <u>Natura 2000 network</u>, and the <u>IAS Regulation</u>, and will support achieving the objectives of the <u>EU's biodiversity strategy for 2030</u>, part of the <u>EU Green Deal</u>.

The Circular economy and quality of life sub-programme aims at facilitating the transition toward a sustainable, circular, toxic-free, energy-efficient and climate-resilient economy and at protecting, restoring and improving the quality of the environment, either through direct interventions or by supporting the integration of those objectives in other policies.

The Climate Change Mitigation and Adaptation sub-programme will contribute to the shift towards a sustainable, energy-efficient, renewable energy-based, climate-neutral and resilient economy, thereby contributing to sustainable development.

Building on the success of the Intelligent Energy Europe (2003-2013) and Horizon 2020 Energy Efficiency (2014-2020) programmes, the LIFE Clean Energy Transition sub-programme continues to support the delivery of EU policies in the field of sustainable energy, in particular, the European Green Deal, the Energy Union (2030 energy and climate targets) and the European Union's 2050 long-term decarbonisation strategy.

NEW ROUND OF MSCA CALLS WORTH €1.25 EUR IS OPEN

On 23 April 2024, the European Commission announced new calls worth over €1.25 billion to support research under the Marie Sklodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) of Horizon Europe. The funding will develop excellent doctoral and postdoctoral programmes, and support collaborative research and innovation projects:

• The MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships call, with a budget of €417.2 million, opens on 23 April 2024 and will close on 11 September 2024.

Later this year, two other major calls will open to support excellent doctoral programmes and international collaborative research projects:

- The MSCA Doctoral Networks call, with a budget of €608.6 million, will open on 29 May and close on 27 November 2024.
- The MSCA Staff Exchanges call, with a budget of €99.47 million, will open on 19 September and close on 5 February 2025.

FEBS-FELLOWSHIPS

The FEBS Fellowships programme is a highly competitive and respected programme for early-stage researchers. Most of its schemes over the years have supported graduate students and early-career researchers in the molecular life sciences in the FEBS area to move to and carry out a period of research in a lab in a different FEBS country, thus broadening their experience and training, giving access to additional research techniques and expertise, and facilitating international collaboration.

Types of FEBS fellowships:

- Short-Term Fellowships are for scientists who have obtained their PhD degree within the past six years, and PhD students who have at least one published paper as a main author in an international scientific journal. Applications may be made at any time, but an application should be submitted at least three months before the proposed starting date
- Summer Fellowships are for PhD students and Master's students. Apply by 1 April each year (the call normally opens in February).
- Collaborative Developmental Scholarships are for PhD students or early/mid-career PhD holders in certain disadvantaged FEBS countries. Applications may be made at any time, but an application should be submitted at least three months before the proposed starting date.
