### **WISEGRAD GRANTS -WISEGRAD GRANT, WISEGRAD GRANT+, STRATEGIC GRANT**

Visegrad Fund annually allocates approximately EUR 10 million to hundreds of Visegrad cooperation projects and mobility programs across Central and Eastern Europe.

The project should be implemented in a consortium

**Visegrad grant-** The international consortium should be composed from at least 3 V4 countries OR Bilateral cross-border cooperation of at least 2 organizations from 2 neighboring V4 countries also qualify for support with projects taking place within a 40-km radius from the border and focusing on a local issue

**Visegrad grant+-** active involvement of at least 3 V4 countries and 1 entity from the Eastern Partnership region (EaP) or the Western Balkans countries (WB) at minimum (3xV4 + 1xEaP/WB format). However, if the applicant is from one of the EaP or WB countries, it is enough to involve two V4 countries in the project consortium, if another EaP/WB country is also involved (2xV4 + 2xEaP/WB format).

**Strategic grant-** Projects must be developed by organizations from all V4 countries

## **SWISS NATIONAL SCIENCE FOUNDATION- MULTILATERAL ACADEMIC PROJECT**

MAPS promotes knowledge circulation by providing cross-border collaboration opportunities with Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Poland and Romania.

MAPS will be implemented through Joint Research Projects that are aimed at promoting collaborative projects with clearly defined goals, involving at least one applicant based in Switzerland and two to five additional applicants from two to five of the participating EU-13 countries. Research is carried out at the respective research facilities involved, while reciprocal visits and short stays may also be supported.

The maximum amount of funding for each team in each country is 350,000 francs for four years.

The JRPs have a duration of between 36 and 48 months. The call for proposals is open to all research areas.

## COST- EUROPEAN COOPERATION IN SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

COST funds interdisciplinary research networks.

The funding a COST Action receives covers the expenses of networking activities rather than research. As such is used to organise and fund events, Short-term Scientific Missions, Training Schools, communication activities, and virtual networking tools. An estimated **€125,000** is made available for a COST Action **in its first year** and an average of **€150,000 per year for the other 3 years**.

**Deadline: 23. October 2024.**

Participation in COST Actions has led to significant results and follow-up in terms of the number of proposals submitted for collaborative research in Framework Programmes, with a success rate which more than triple the average success rates for these programmes (**37% success rate**). By funding networking, COST acts as a pre-portal for further research and innovation funding such as Horizon Europe, the European Union's Framework Programme for Research and Innovation.

### **NEW ROUND OF MSCA CALLS WORTH €1.25 EUR IS OPEN**

On 23 April 2024, the European Commission announced new calls worth over €1.25 billion to support research under the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions (MSCA) of Horizon Europe. The funding will develop excellent doctoral and postdoctoral programmes, and support collaborative research and innovation projects:

- The **MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowships** call, with a budget of €417.2 million, opens on 23 April 2024 and will close on 11 September 2024.

Later this year, two other major calls will open to support excellent doctoral programmes and international collaborative research projects:

- The **MSCA Doctoral Networks call**, with a budget of €608.6 million, will open on 29 May and close on 27 November 2024.
- The **MSCA Staff Exchanges call**, with a budget of €99.47 million, will open on 19 September and close on 5 February 2025.

## FEBS-FELLOWSHIPS

The FEBS Fellowships programme is a highly competitive and respected programme for early-stage researchers. Most of its schemes over the years have supported graduate students and early-career researchers in the molecular life sciences in the FEBS area to move to and carry out a period of research in a lab in a different FEBS country, thus broadening their experience and training, giving access to additional research techniques and expertise, and facilitating international collaboration.

Types of FEBS fellowships:

- **Short-Term Fellowships** are for scientists who have obtained their PhD degree within the past six years, and PhD students who have at least one published paper as a main author in an international scientific journal. Applications may be made at any time, but an application should be submitted **at least three months before the proposed starting date**
- **Summer Fellowships** are for PhD students and Master's students. Apply by **1 April each year** (the call normally opens in February).
- **Collaborative Developmental Scholarships** are for PhD students or early/mid-career PhD holders in certain disadvantaged FEBS countries. Applications may be made at any time, but an application should be submitted **at least three months before the proposed starting date**.

## **HUMBOLDT RESEARCH AWARD**

Eligible for nomination are researchers whose fundamental discoveries, new theories or findings have had a lasting effect on their discipline beyond their immediate research area and who are expected, moreover, to continue producing outstanding research in the future.

## **EMBO- SCIENTIFIC EXCHANGE GRANT**

Supporting international collaborations, enabling transfer of expertise. ## **WESTERN BALKANS – VISEGRAD FELLOWSHIPS**

The Western Balkans–Visegrad Fellowships allow WB6 citizens to apply for short-term fellowships at V4 research institutions (in Czechia, Poland, Hungary, or Slovakia). Reciprocally, V4 applicants can apply for fellowships at WB6 institutions (in Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Kosovo\*, or Serbia).

The program is jointly funded by the International Visegrad Fund and the Western Balkans Fund.

The fellowships are provided for a limited period ranging from 2 to 10 weeks during which the respective fellow is to conduct (or participate in) research, hold lectures or seminars at a higher-education level, or study or review specific sets of written or other materials available in public archives or libraries.

Fellows must be doctoral students or hold a doctoral degree.
