Erasmus+ Teacher Academies

The Erasmus+ Teacher Academies aim to facilitate networking, knowledge sharing, mobility and provide teachers and trainers with learning opportunities at all phases of teachers' and trainers' careers by promoting close cooperation between organisations active in initial and continuing teacher education and training, complement other work done in achieving the Education Area, and help transfer the results to national and regional policy making and eventually to teacher education and support for schools.

They are to build on the innovations and effective practice that exists within national teacher education and European cooperation and develop them further. Specific attention is to be paid to dissemination and exploitation of effective practice across countries and teacher education providers, and to ensuring feedback and impact also at policy level.

The coordinating organisation must be a Teacher Education Institution.

Consortium composition: A minimum of 6 applicants from a minimum of 4 EU Member States or third countries associated to the Programme, which complies with the following conditions:

- A minimum of 4 nationally established providers of initial teacher education from 3 different EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme, and
- a minimum of 1 nationally established provider of continuing professional development (in-service training) for teachers, and
- a minimum of 1 practice/training school.

The consortium may also include affiliated entities or associated partners, other organisations with relevant expertise in teacher education and/or bodies defining standards, qualifications or quality assurance for teacher education.

The maximum EU grant per project is EUR 1 500 000

MSCA COFUND 2025

MSCA COFUND co-finances new or existing doctoral programmes and postdoctoral fellowship schemes with the aim of spreading the best practices of the MSCA including international, inter-sectoral and interdisciplinary research training, as well as international and cross-sectoral mobility of researchers at all stages of their career.

In practice, MSCA COFUND provides complementary funding for doctoral or postdoctoral programmes managed by entities established in EU Member States or Horizon Europe Associated Countries. Those co-funded programmes must follow MSCA's good practice in terms of international recruitment and minimum standard of employment for the recruited fellows as described in the European Charter for Researchers.

Proposed programmes can cover any research disciplines ("bottom-up"), but exceptionally can also focus on specific disciplines, notably when they are based on national or regional Research and Innovation Strategies for Smart Specialisation (RIS3 strategies). In this case, the range of covered disciplines should allow reasonable flexibility for the researchers to define their topic.

COFUND takes the form of:

- A) Doctoral programmes
- B) Postdoctoral Programmes

Creative Europe – Culture – Cooperation projects

With a budget of around €60 million, the action will foster cooperation between organisations active in the field of culture, to increase the cross-border dimension of creation and circulation of European artistic content. It will also encourage the development, experimentation, dissemination, and application of new and innovative practices.

The action will support at least 130 projects.

The deadline for applications is 13 May 2025.

European cooperation projects are open to all the cultural and creative sectors. However, considering that this action is part of the Culture strand of Creative Europe, projects with exclusive audio-visual content and/or exclusively composed of organisations from the audio-visual sector are not eligible to apply.

The call covers three (3) topics/categories, depending on the scale of the project(s):

- Small scale: 3 partners, 3 countries, 200 000 EUR max EU grant, 80% EU co-funding
- Medium scale: 5 partners, 5 countries, 1 000 000 EUR max EU grant, 70% EU co-funding
- Large scale: 10 partners, 10 countries, 2 000 000 EUR max EU grant, 60% EU co-funding

Eurostars

Eurostars is part of the European Partnership on Innovative SMEs. The partnership is co-funded by the European Union through Horizon Europe.

Eurostars is a funding instrument that supports innovative SMEs and project partners (large companies, universities, research organisations and other types of organisations) by funding international collaborative R&D and innovation projects. By participating, organisations can access public funding for international collaborative R&D projects in all fields.

You can submit your R&D and innovation project application between 10 January 2025 to 13 March 2025 at 14:00 (Brussels time) using the project platform (myeurekaproject.org). Your project consortium must have an innovative SME in the leading role, but it can also include other types of organisations like large companies, universities, research organisations and more.

Human Frontiers Research Program

HFSP Research Grants support innovative basic research into fundamental biological problems with emphasis placed on novel and interdisciplinary approaches that involve scientific exchanges across national and disciplinary boundaries.

Participation of scientists from disciplines outside the traditional life sciences such as biophysics, chemistry, computational biology, computer science, engineering, mathematics, nanoscience or physics is recommended because such collaborations have opened up new approaches for understanding the complex structures and regulatory networks that characterize living organisms, their evolution and interactions.

Research grants are provided for teams of scientists from different countries who wish to combine their expertise in innovative approaches to questions that could not be answered by individual laboratories. Preliminary results are not required and applicants are expected to develop new lines of research through the research collaboration.

Two types of Grant are available: Research Grants – Early Career and Research Grants – Program. Both provide three years support for 2 – 4 member teams. Awards are fixed sums dependent upon team size.

Wellcome Foundation - Climate Impacts Awards: Unlocking urgent climate action by making the health effects of climate change visible

The aim of this scheme is to make the impacts of climate change on physical and mental health visible to drive urgent climate policy action at scale. Wellcome Foundation will fund transdisciplinary teams to deliver short-term, high-impact projects that maximise policy outcomes by combining evidence generation with influencing and engagement strategies.

In scope:

- Proposals where the primary focus is on the current or future direct and environmentally mediated physical or mental health outcomes attributable to climate change (Haines and Ebi 2019 for definitions), making the health effects of climate change visible
- Proposals that include the three key elements of:
 - an evidence gap that can be filled in the short time available
 - a clear policy pathway to influence change
 - an engaged research approach with key stakeholders identified (including a communication strategy)

Lead applicant career stage: mid-career researcher, established researcher;

Administering organisation location: anywhere in the world (apart from mainland China);

Funding amount: up to 2.5 million GBP;

Funding duration: up to 3 years;

Coapplicants: accepted.

Visegrad Grants -Visegrad Grant, Visegrad Grant+, Strategic Grant

Visegrad Fund annually allocates approximately EUR 10 million to hundreds of Visegrad cooperation projects and mobility programs across Central and Eastern Europe. The project should be implemented in a consortium.

Visegrad Grant

The international consortium should be composed from at least 3 V4 countries OR Bilateral cross-border cooperation of at least 2 organizations from 2 neighboring V4 countries also qualify for support with projects taking place within a 40-km radius from the border and focusing on a local issue.

Projects must address at least one of the objectives of the grant program's seven focus areas: Culture and Common Identity; Education and Capacity Building; Innovation, R&D, Entrepreneurship; Democratic Values and the Media; Public Policy and Institutional Partnership; Regional Development, Environment and Tourism; Social Development.

Visegrad Grant+

Active involvement of at least 3 V4 countries and 1 entity from the Eastern Partnership region (EaP) or the Western Balkans countries (WB) at minimum (3xV4 + 1xEaP/WB format). However, if the applicant is from one of the EaP or WB countries, it is enough to involve two V4 countries in the project consortium, if another EaP/WB country is also involved (2xV4 + 2xEaP/WB format).

Projects must address at least one of the objectives of the grant program's seven focus areas: Culture and Common Identity; Education and Capacity Building; Innovation, R&D, Entrepreneurship; Democratic Values and the Media; Public Policy and Institutional Partnership; Regional Development, Environment and Tourism; Social Development.

Strategic Grant

Projects must be developed by organizations from all V4 countries.

Projects must clearly address one of the annual strategic priorities of the Visegrad Group. Strategic priorities in 2025: Promoting volunteering in the V4 region, Promoting shared values, Supporting water management and flood protection cooperation in the region.

Although Visegrad, Visegrad+ and Strategic Grants have no strict limitation for the size of the financial support you can apply for, the average project budget does not exceed €30.000. Each submitted proposal is evaluated on its merit, taking into account the potential outreach and impact of the project, the elaboration of the grant budget in the "Outputs" section and adherence to the "value-for-money" principle.

The disciplines supported include archaeology, biological anthropology, paleoanthropology, primate behavioral ecology, genetics, geology, anatomy, morphology, paleobotany, and paleoclimatology.

Our current funding focus areas include:

- Paleoanthropology of the Miocene, Pliocene, and Pleistocene
- Primates: Evolution, behavior, morphology, ecology, endocrinology, genetics, isotope studies

Amounts

- Up to \$20,000 for PhD candidates

Who can apply

- Your research must be relevant to human origins and evolution.
- Applications are open to advanced doctoral students or post-PhD researchers.
- PhD students must be advanced to candidacy (all but dissertation).
- There are no citizenship requirements. Applications are open to candidates from anywhere in the world.
- Applicants must be affiliated with an institution such as a university or museum. We do not give directly to individuals.
- Resubmittals are welcome and encouraged.
- If you have received a Leakey Foundation grant in the past, you must complete all reporting requirements before receiving a new one.

Eligible expenses

- The grant can only be used for expenses directly related to your research and essential to the project such as travel, living expenses during fieldwork, supplies, and research expenses.
- Aid is not offered for salary and/or fringe benefits of applicant or senior project personnel, child care, equipment, travel to meetings, institutional overhead, publication costs, or institutional support.

Worldwide Cancer Research

The goal is to support research that seeks to answer the difficult questions in cancer biology. WCR is looking for innovative and truly novel ideas that have the potential to revolutionise our understanding of cancer and how to beat it.

They award project grants of 12 to 36 months in length to support basic, fundamental or translational research into the prevention, diagnosis or treatment of cancer. They do not prioritise any field of research within this.

WCR welcomes research that draws on epidemiological, behavioural and clinical data to provide a starting point for a new avenue of research. Multidisciplinary or discipline-hopping projects are encouraged where this helps stimulate innovation.

The principal investigator on the application must be a suitably qualified researcher (minimum of PhD followed by three years research experience, or equivalent qualification or research experience).

The WCR awards grants to principal investigators based at any not-for-profit research institute in the world.

The maximum budget allowed is £275,000, but it should be noted that most of the three-year grants we award have a budget of around £200,000.

The 2025 Grant Round is now open. The Grant Round will close on 31st March 2025 at 16:00 UTC or if they reach their 500 applications limit.

University of Alberta – Hungarian Doctoral Research Fellowship For advanced students in Hungary

The Hungarian Doctoral Research Fellowship is tenable in the 2025-2026 academic year at the Wirth Institute for Austrian and Central European Studies of the University of Alberta in Edmonton, Canada for a period of eight (8) months, commencing 1 October 2025 through to 31 May 2026. The Fellowship is valued at CAN \$ 27,600.00 and will be paid in equal monthly installments at the end of each month beginning October 2025.

The successful candidate will hold this fellowship at the Wirth Institute for Austrian and Central European Studies, and is expected to be actively engaged in Ph.D. thesis research. Successful candidates are also expected to participate in the Institute's cultural, scholarly and academic activities, and events, particularly the development of academic relationships with institutions in Hungary. A willingness to engage with the local Hungarian community and serve as a liaison between that community and the Faculty of Arts is also a requirement.

Young scholars from disciplines in the Humanities, Social Sciences or Fine Arts (especially from the field of Anthropology, Art and Design, Classics, Cultural Studies, Drama, East Asian Studies, Economics, English, Film Studies, History, Linguistics, Modern Languages, Music, Philosophy, Political Science, Psychology, Sociology and Women's Studies) are invited to apply. Candidates should be Hungarian citizens enrolled in a Ph.D. programme at a Hungarian university at all-but-dissertation level and have an excellent command of spoken and written English. The purpose of

the fellowship is to offer a research stipend to complete writing the dissertation. A sound reading knowledge of either a Slavic language or German and a proven research record (ideally in the form of publications), would be an asset.

Federation of European Biochemical Societies (FEBS) fellowships

The FEBS Fellowships programme is a highly competitive and respected programme for early-stage researchers. Most of its schemes over the years have supported graduate students and early-career researchers in the molecular life sciences in the FEBS area to move to and carry out a period of research in a lab in a different FEBS country, thus broadening their experience and training, giving access to additional research techniques and expertise, and facilitating international collaboration.

Types of FEBS fellowships:

- Short-Term Fellowships are for scientists who have obtained their PhD degree within the past six years, and PhD students who have at least one published paper as a main author in an international scientific journal. Applications may be made at any time, but an application should be submitted at least three months before the proposed starting date
- Summer Fellowships are for PhD students and Master's students. Apply by 1 April each year (the call normally opens in February).
- Ukrainian Short-Term Fellowships are for active molecular life scientists from Ukraine who have a PhD. Apply any time.

MAPS evaluation timetable

MAPS is a multilateral initiative that supports collaborative research projects between researchers in Switzerland and their colleagues in Bulgaria, Croatia, Hungary, Poland and Romania.

The SNSF received 334 proposals in response to its MAPS call, which closed on 1 July 2024. In the formal preliminary review, the eligibility of applicants and their institutions will now be verified, among other criteria. The evaluation meeting will take place in March 2025. The results are expected to be communicated in April 2025. A total of around 20-25 applications can be funded.
